## Hands-on look at tribal art



The Karo tribes of Ethiopia are expert body painters

MOST travellers can recognise a couple of destinations on any itinerary, but in the case of Arba Minch, Murulle, Turmi, Mago and Jinka I was stumped; only the arrival airport of Addis Ababa gave the clue. They're destinations offered by Journeys by Design's (01273 623790) new tailor-made expeditions to southern Ethiopia, which is almost unexplored by western visitors.

"It's Africa at its rawest and wildest, and it's not for the faint-hearted," says managing director Will Jones, who lived there for eight years. On a 13-day journey following the Rift Valley lakes south into the lower Omo basin, you'll see a chain of sparkling lakes, abundant bird life, fish and crocodiles, plus a kaleidoscope of cultures, he promises.

The area is peopled with remote tribes, and meeting them, visiting their markets and watching their dances plays a major part in the holiday. Former hippo hunters, the Ganjuli and Guji, ply the water around lakes Chamo and Abaya in high-prowed boats similar to those depicted on the tombs of ancient pharaohs. Further south, the Konso base their cults around the breeding and veneration of serpents, and the Karo tribes are expert body painters. Hamer women, meanwhile, wear their hair in dense ringlets, topped with headdresses of aluminium.

The cost of the tour is £1,787 for each of four, £2,634 for each of two which covers all transport, porterage, meals, accommodation in the Sheraton at Addis Ababa, and camps and lodges en route. Flights are not included but Design will organise those on request.
