
The future of African travel is RARE, the rarest of adventures, designed to make sustainable travel support at-risk ecosystems - respectfully, effectively, and for the long term.

We committed Journeys by Design in 1999 to protecting Africa's wildernesses and we continue to generate surplus to distribute wealth. Last year alone we collaborated with our sister charity Wild Philanthropy to deploy US\$ 359,840 into our core ecosystem projects. We facilitated the donation of US\$ 175,840 to conservation and community projects directly supporting 52,561 hectares of land, and reinvested US\$ 1,189,959 back into the African economy. We have raised over US\$ 6 million for charities globally over the last 20 years.


Underlining this commitment, we are now a member of 1% for the Planet. Please join us on this RARE and important journey.

CHARACTER


These are true adventures of the heart, where deep emotional connections are made, and where character is formed.


POSITIVE IMPACT

Included in the pricing, therefore, of any RARE itinerary is a minimum US\$ 5,000 environmental pledge to support one or more of three at-risk ecosystems in East Africa through our sister charity Wild Philanthropy, which is a US registered charity and 501(c)(3).
